Healthcare: He Made It Worse

President Obama promised that his health care law would make health care better for all Americans. Over a year later, we've actually seen how his law:

1. Increases Costs

Since Obamacare was signed into law, American families have seen their premiums increase 19%.

2. Causes People to Lose the Coverage They Have

A recent McKinsey and Company study reports that 30% of employers will definitely or probably stop offering employer-sponsored coverage after 2014 – when Obamacare is fully into effect.

3. Raises Taxes

The new law raises over \$550 billion in taxes – including on wages, dividends, capital gains, over the counter cold medicine, tanning beds, and medical devices.

4. Crushes Jobs

The National Federation of Independent Businesses reports that the law's employer mandate alone will cost 1.6 million jobs – with 66% of the jobs coming from small businesses.

5. Rations Seniors' Care

Created IPAB - a board of unelected, unaccountable bureaucrats who will limit seniors' care.

6. Raids Medicare

Robbed \$500 billion from Medicare to start a new Washington program.

7. Hurts Businesses

Obamacare's mandates are so expensive that the Administration has been forced to give waivers to businesses and unions that cannot afford the law's crushing costs.

8. Worsens Doctor Shortage

In September 2010, the Association of American Medical Colleges reported doctor shortages will be 50% worse than originally projected by 2015.

9. Provides Coverage – But Not Care

Locks 16 million people into a broken Medicaid program.

10. Limits States' Flexibility

Maintenance of Effort requirements take away state choice in Medicaid.
